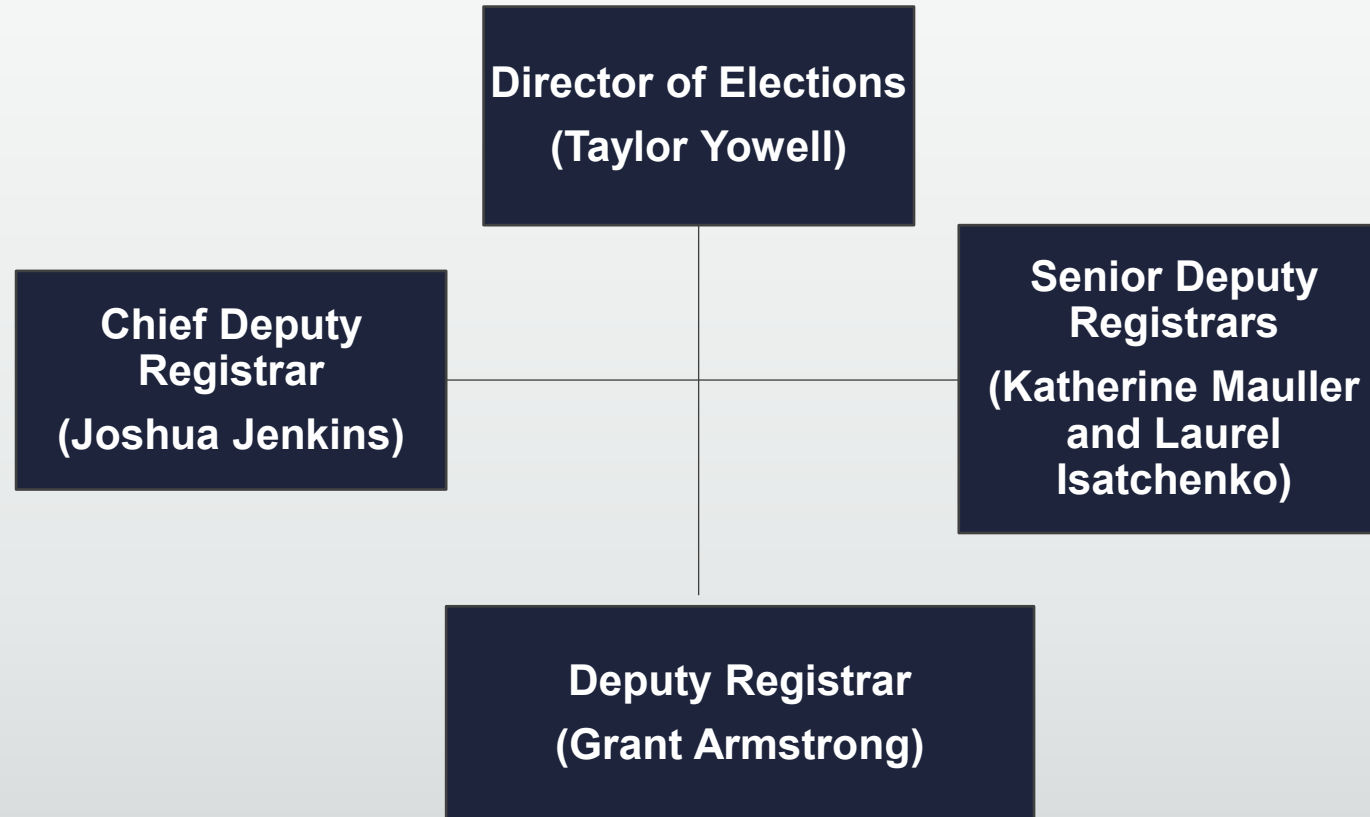
Office of Voter Registration and Elections

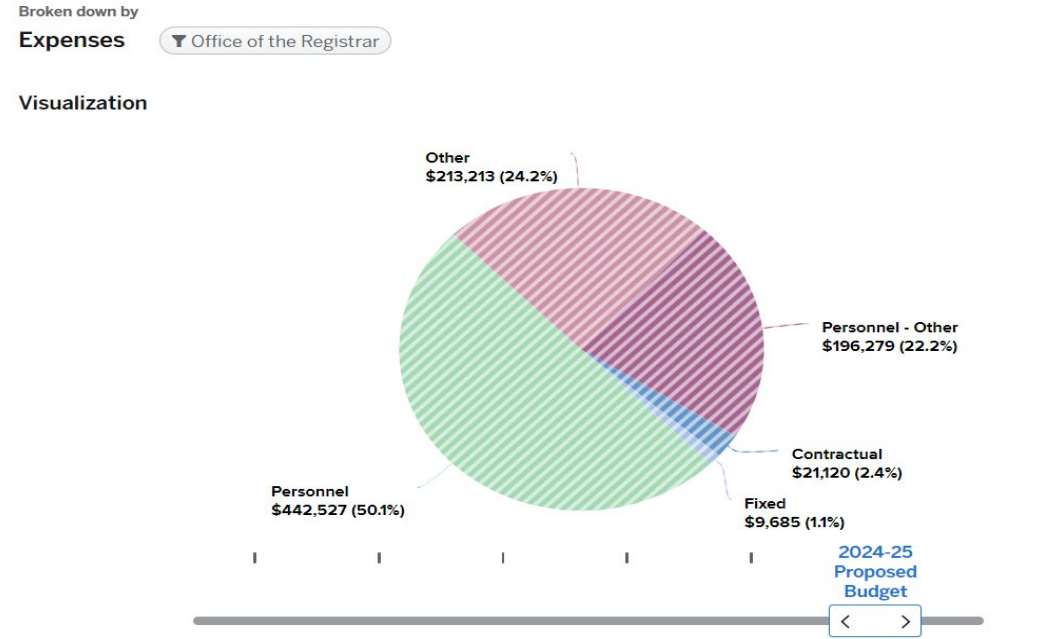
