


 ISO Class 1 fire department indicates the highest level of fire protection within a community, focusing on department performance.





## **Emergency Services by the Numbers**




- 7,884 Total Calls for Service

# **Emergency Medical Services**




- EMS accounts for 64% of our total calls for service
