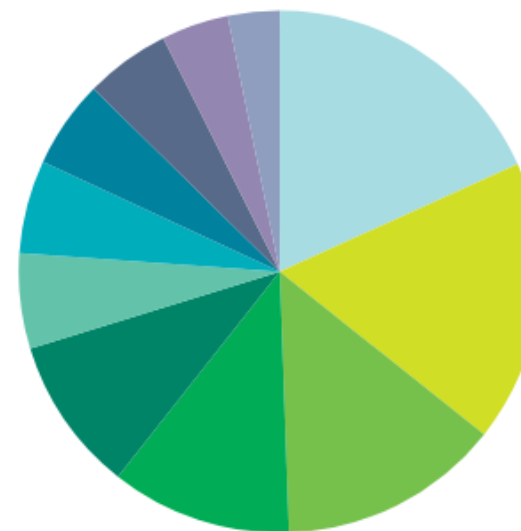

Affordable Care Act (January 1)

ACA premiums are proposed to rise by about 75%

- Higher monthly premiums
- Potential for higher out-of-pocket costs

388,856 Virginians enrolled in the ACA Marketplace in 2025

12,054 Albemarle and Charlottesville residents enrolled in the ACA Marketplace (estimated)

Medicaid Changes

Reapply every 6 months (2028)

Work requirements (2028)

- 80 hrs of work or community service per month or meet exemption criteria to enroll in and maintain coverage

14,812 Albemarle residents with Medicaid

8,732 Charlottesville residents with Medicaid
